All is well at the Education Department. As I write this, it is 24 days until Spring. They said that 2020 was the year from hell; 2021 is the year hell froze over.

Speaking of weather, our **Weather Course** is moving right alone. This week we will be covering hurricanes, hopefully none of which we will see this year, and we will be ending the course on March 16.

We recently completed our first ever **ABC** Zoom class with 16 successful graduates. We complied with all NASBLA (National Association of State Boating Law Administrators) and USPS on-line course requirements, which includes monitoring of the final exam by computer camera. Teaching via Zoom presented several challenges, but based on the final grades, both the students and instructors overcame them. The class average on the final exam was 90. Interestingly, 90 is about 12 higher that the approximate average age of the four instructors. This tells us two things: one, you can teach old dogs new tricks and two, maybe we need to get some new and less experienced instructors. Seriously though, this course represented the best of a Captree group effort by our instructors: Gene Johnson, Charlie Virga, Bob Silz and me; our marketing and PR folks: Michael Richter, Len Schiede, Garry Biggs, Frank Verderber, and Mike Mercurio; and most important our technical support: Jerry Cappa and Michael Richter.

Another 5-week **ABC** Zoom class will begin on Tuesday, March 30. Please do all you can to make others aware of this course. They can contact Michael Richter at 516-526-8177 to register.

Although Spring is not here yet, we are already thinking about our Fall course offerings. In addition to **ABC**, we are tentatively planning to offer **Boat Handling** beginning in late October. **Boat Handling**, which replaces the old **Seamanship** course, is the first of the advanced grade USPS courses. It has been redesigned into six classes, followed by a final examination.

Rules of the Road: A Practical Approach

Confidence in Docking and Undocking: Slow-Speed Maneuvering

Boating with Confidence: Handling Your Boat Underway Anchoring with Assurance: Don't Get Carried Away

Emergencies on Board: Preparation to Handle Common Problems

Knots and Line Handling: The Knots You Need to Know

Each of these can also be taken individually as a seminar. At the next few Captree meetings, we will be soliciting our members to ascertain interest in either the entire course or individual seminar(s). They will also be offered to the general public. We can teach this class either in a traditional classroom mode or via Zoom, or possibly a combination of both. Materials are available in the usual print format or as an E-book. MEMBER INVOLVEMENT

Whew, we just came through January and February, both with terrible weather. I hope all that bad weather is behind us. I know March can come in like a lion and go out like a lamb but let us wish for lamb-like weather all month long, as nothing can be worse than what we have been having.

National's Annual Meeting was just held over a two-week period in February starting with opening remarks from the USPS Chief Commander on February 15th and ending with a cocktail party on February 26th, both virtual via Zoom. Between those two events were daily committee meetings and seminars, again all virtual via Zoom. In addition to me, both Mike Richter and Frank Verderber participated in some of those seminars and found them extremely useful. "Virtual via Zoom" seems to be the norm today and maybe into the future.

Before I get into March's events, let me congratulate Captree as it will be celebrating its 70th Anniversary on March 19th. **Congratulations Captree!**

There are two major events taking place in March, one at the District level and one in Captree, and both will be virtual via Zoom. The first event is District's Spring Conference and Change-of-Watch on March 12th and the second is Captree's Annual Meeting on Wednesday, March 24th. What is the Annual meeting all about? It is Captree's elections of new Bridge Officers, Assistant Officers, Executive Committee Members'-at-Large and elected Committee members for Captree's new fiscal year which runs from May 1, 2021 through April 30, 2022.

Included in this edition of the *LOG* is the Slate of nominees who have stepped forward to lead and guide Captree through its next fiscal year. For the first time in a long time, our Commander Carol Johnson will not be continuing as Commander. Carol has served as Captree's Commander for four one-year terms, in addition to stepping forward to lead us after Commander Lea Tracy's passing. We all extend a big Thank You to Carol!!!!

As you can see from the Slate of nominees, there remains one position open on the Nominating Committee and one on the Audit Committee. Just yesterday, I expressed my interest in the Nominating Committee position. If anyone is interested in the Audit Committee position, please let our Commander know. Serving on this committee requires auditing the Treasurer's books periodically during the year or, as requested by the Executive Committee.

Attending Captree's Annual meeting via Zoom and casting your vote shows that you care for and have an interest in the future of Captree. Remember, Captree is your squadron; it belongs to each of you. What each of you put into Captree is what you will get out of it. We have several members that have held this organization together in the past and continue working hard year after year to make it grow. They need your help as they cannot do it by themselves.

One of the ways to help is to promote our ABC boating classes, especially since all boaters will have to complete a safe boating class by January 2025. We have another "America's Boating Course" starting on Tuesday, March 31st and running for 5 consecutive weeks. All classes will be virtual via Zoom so there is no driving to and from a classroom in the dark. This is our second ABC class this year. The first class ran for 5 weeks during January and February and went extremely well considering it was our first attempt at teaching the ABC course via Zoom. I have to thank George Tracy for putting it all together, and to Gene Johnson and Mike Richter who assisted George. In addition, Gene & George both served as proctors along with Bob Silz and me. In fact, my assistance was from Florida. Technology is great! Not to be forgotten is Jerry Cappa who worked the Power Point slides and moved the curser to items that we wanted to highlight.

Sixteen students took the final exam virtually and all passed with a combined grade of 90.6. Logistically, students took the exam at home and then emailed their answer sheets to George for grading. Then, I made their certificates here in Florida and emailed them to Gene Johnson who printed them. He also laminated a small wallet card indicting completion of the ABC course and mailed both the certificate and wallet card to them via the US Post Office. Seems like a lot of steps but it all went smoothly.

Some other events taking place this month include the beginning of Daylight Savings Time on Sunday, March 14th (set you clocks forward one hour Saturday night when you go to bed), St. Patrick's Day on Wednesday, March 17th, and Passover and Palm Sunday on March 27th and 28th.

That's all for this month. Remember, we need you to be part of this organization; take a job and be involved in support of Captree.
