All is well at the Education Department.

We have begun our third **ABC** Zoom class with 14 students enrolled. The class will end on June 15. I do not anticipate additional education activities until Fall. We will, however, be planning for our **Boat Handling** course, which is described below. We will need to decide on in-person, zoom, or a blended delivery method for this course as well as our **ABC** courses. At this time, we do not have all the data we need to make this decision as we are uncertain about room availability and USPS and governmental regulations. Based on our success with the **ABC** Zoom classes, I am in favor of continuing them, however, we will have to wait and see. As of now, our approval for Zoom **ABC** classes by USPS expires at the end of the year.

Boat Handling will begin on Tuesday, October 14. **It** replaces the old **Seamanship** course and is the first of the advanced grade USPS courses. The cost is \$75 for members, \$175 for non-members. It has been redesigned into six classes, followed by a final examination. The six classes are:

- Rules of the Road: A Practical Approach
- Confidence in Docking and Undocking: Slow-Speed Maneuvering
- Boating with Confidence: Handling Your Boat Underway
- Anchoring with Assurance: Don't Get Carried Away
- Emergencies on Board: Preparation to Handle Common Problems
- Knots and Line Handling: The Knots You Need to Know
